



For the past five years the O. & C. has been making an additional payment of 25 per cent for back taxes accrued prior to 1937. The 1943 payments have liquidated this obligation. Henceforth, 25 per cent will accrue to the Federal Treasury. The remaining 25 per cent is available for administration of the O. & C. lands, including protection from fire which is contracted to the State of Oregon Forestry Depart-

Forming one of the nation's largest testing grounds for scientific forest management, timber cutting as required by congressional mandate, is conducted on a sustained yield basis which stipulates that no more timber shall be cut each year than can be replaced by natural growth. Cutting is conducted in such a manner that recreational values are protected, timber growth is accelerated, and natural reforestation is obtained.
