INTEREST SHOWN IN BLUEBERRIES
 Rather widespread interest in the production of blueberries in Oregon is indicated by requests for information being received by Henry Hartman, head of the Department of Horticulture at OSC. To answer these, Prof. Hartman has just written a brief extension circular, No. 428, entitled "The Blueberry in Oregon," which tells where and under what conditions these berries are likely to be grown satisfactorily and which gives the main points in their culture.

BLAME FLOOR MARKS ON WAR, THEN RUB SOLVENT
 Blame the war for the black marks appearing on floors from rubber soles and heels, suggests Lois A. Lutz, extension specialist in home management at Oregon State College, who then tells what to do to get rid of them.

The carbon black in rubber, which causes the marks, has been increased because of the rubber shortage, as it makes rubber more durable. The inconvenience it causes is just one of those things that civilians must put up with if they are to have rubber footwear at all.

These black marks may be removed with liquid wax, turpentine, or cleaning fluid, says Miss Lutz. The grease solvents, such as carbon tetrachloride or turpentine, remove wax from the floor along with the black marks, hence a re-coating of wax is necessary after the spots or streaks are cleaned off. Use of liquid wax will do both operations at once.

Miss Lutz advises removing the marks at least once a week, as they are harder to take off the longer they remain on the floor.
