

BEAUTY TREATMENT

At the first sign of rust on refrigerator shelves use this treatment: Wash shelves with a mild scouring powder and hot water; dry well with a soft, clean cloth and, using another soft clean cloth apply a thin protective coating of het melted paraffin, Although primarily a beauty treatment, this helps to retard the harmful spread of rust at its starting point in the joints and seams of the shelves.

USE MORE CABBAGE

An all-time record crop of cabbage is now on the market and the government asks your nelp in seeing that it doesn't go to waste. It is a very good source of vitamin C and may be used as a partial substitute for other foods nigh in vitamin C, such as oranges, grapefruit, and tomatoes. To get the full quota of vitamin C, nowever, Mrs. Julia Kiene, director of the Westinghouse Home Economics Institute, makes these recommendations: (1) Buy firm, fresh heads, not too large, and with green outside leaves when possible; (2) Store in the refrigerator, either in a crisper or vegetable bag, not in a paper sack; (3) Cook as quickly as possible in a covered container, and when preparing cabbage for salads, slaws, etc., chop or shred just before serving.

EXTRA SOILED SPOTS

Collars, cuffs, and neckbands of shirts, rompers, overalls and children's dresses usually need special attention , and for such soiled spots, Westinghouse home economists suggest this treatment. Dissolve 1 cup granulated soap flakes in sufficient boiling water to make a thick jelly. With a soft bristled brush apply soap jelly to heavily soiled spots. Then put the garment into the wash with the other clothes.


