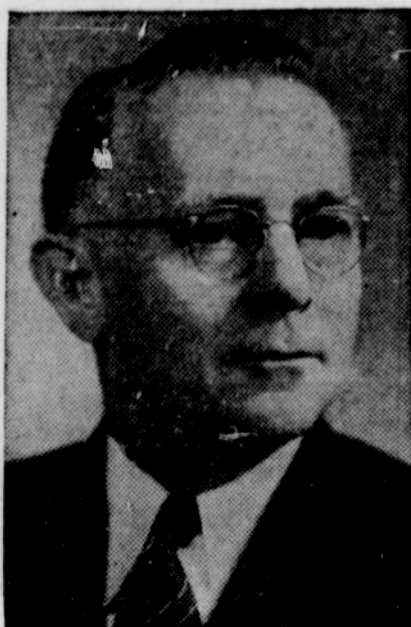

CIVIL SERVICE SEEKS PRICE SPECIALIST
