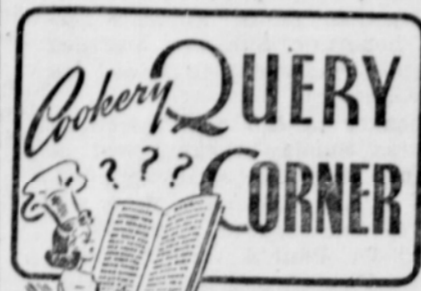

HOW ARE HAM AND CORN FRITTERS MADE?



The Ingredients

Mix 1/2 cup ground cooked ham, 1 cup whole grain corn with 1/2 cup corn liquid, and 1 tablespoon minced onion. Sift 2/3 cup flour and 1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder together. Add to ham mixture and blend.



Frying the Fritters

Heat 1 to 2 pounds lard to 375°F. or until a 1-inch cube of bread browns in 40 seconds. Drop by teaspoons into the hot lard and cook until nicely browned. Drain well by using a wire basket or soft paper.



The Finished Fritters

Serve the fritters hot for breakfast, lunch or supper. For breakfast serve them with maple or sugar syrup or citrus marmalade. For lunch or supper serve a fruit salad as the accompaniment.

Keep Oregon Green Association Active

Now that the fire season in the forests is again here, the Keep Oregon Green Association has once more started its campaign to teach the public to be more "fire conscious". There have been various meetings to date, under the direction of Robert E. Dodge, Jackson County chairman of the Keep Oregon Green Association.

The most important organization now working is the Green Guards, organized in the schools throughout the county. These students, numbering some 2,000 in Jackson county, are given badges and service stripes and instructed in forest fire prevention.

Dodge is rapidly organizing other clubs and groups for this work, considered all-important since 60c of every wage dollar in Oregon comes from the lumber industry.

Windshield stickers, window stickers for home, store or office, window display posters, envelope stickers, or almost any type of Keep Oregon Green literature desired may be had free of charge by contacting Dodge at J. P. Dodge and Sons.

Following are a few good fire prevention suggestions for campers: Choose a suitable site in a designated area; never cut or slash growing trees; always carry an axe and shovel in your car; never build a large fire; don't burn tent poles or other camp conveniences put there for your convenience. Camp fires should never be built against standing trees fallen logs, or on beds of deep moss or duff; be sure, doubly sure, that your fire is dead out before you leave it.

When out in the forest, either in your car or afoot, do all you can to Keep Oregon Green.
