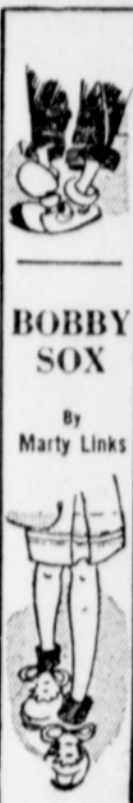
Flies' Eyes Besides the two big eyes, the fly has three little eyes set like a triangle in the top of its head.

Urban Drivers Reports from 23 states in 1944 show that 73 per cent of the drivers involved in automobile accidents were residents of urban areas.

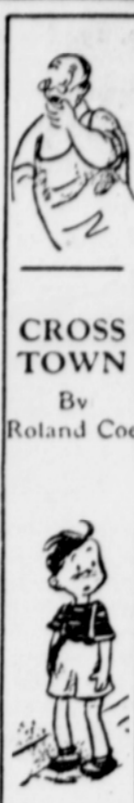

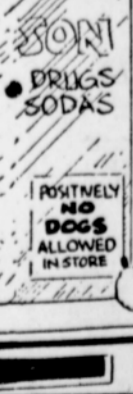
