### Tax on Cut Wood Due On October 15

Timber owners in the Ashland area this month began sending in the first tax payments which are required by the state forest Research and Experimental Tax act. Tax returns are to be filed by each person owning timber which is being harvested. According to the State Tax commissions instructions the timber owner is that person either owning such timber outright or who buys it on contract at the time of harvesting.

Payments are due not later than October 15 on timber harvested during July, August, and September of this year. Revenue from the tax is used for experiment and research.
