Household Hints

If a non-washable article is spotted by water, put a damp cloth over it and press the spot. On some silks and satins, though, water spots are impossible to remove.

Add a little starch when doing up cretonne slipcovers. It will take away that flimsy look and keep the material clean longer.

A little prepared horseradish added to mayonnaise will pep up a salad.

When cotton is scorched, wet the spot with water and cover it with a thick paste of laundry starch. After it dries, sponge it off with peroxide, iron the article and place it in the sun for a few hours.

To keep snow from sticking to the snow shovel, rub it with a candle-stump or piece of paraffin before using.

Iceland's Hot Springs

Iceland, noted for thermal springs and geysers as well as ice and cold, is now piping hot water 10 miles in to its capital city of Reykjavik at the rate of 4,200 gallons per minute. While only domestic heating is now supplied, test wells are being drilled for steam and power purposes.

Aye, There's The Rub

Sometimes a dull finish is desired on varnished surfaces. This may be obtained by rubbing the glossy coating with fine sandpaper, pumice or steel wool. To avoid the labor of rubbing, manufacturers make varnishes which dry with a reduced gloss by adding such materials as wax, metallic soap and finely divided silica.
