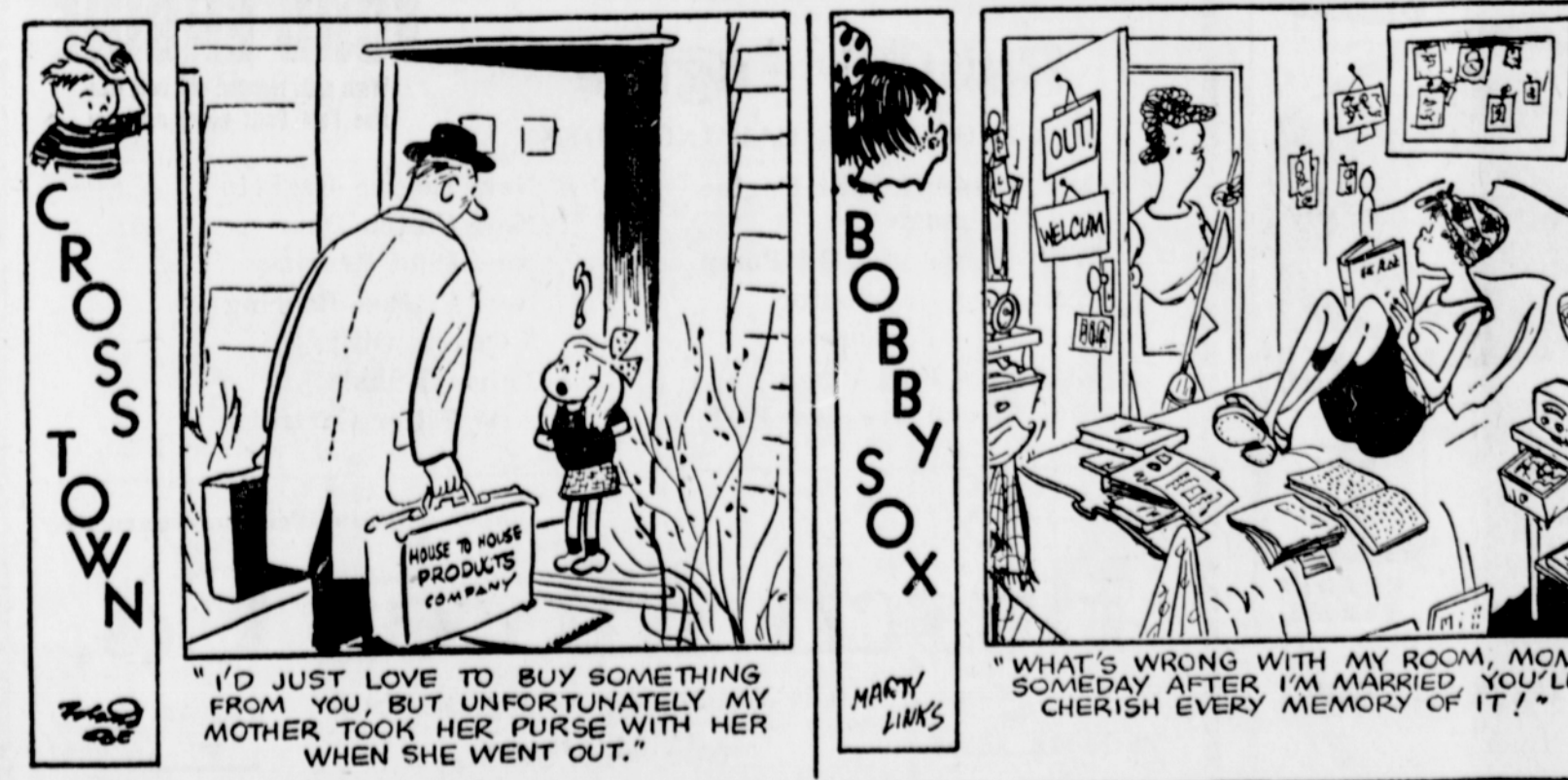

May Cause Mastitis Information assembled by the American Veterinary Medical association indicates that staphylococcal (gangrene-type) mastitis may break out suddenly in a herd following any deviation in the milking routine. For example, if the milking machine goes out of order, or if a new person milks the cows, cases of the disease may appear almost immediately. On the other hand, the staphylococcus germ may be harbored by cows indefinitely without causing trouble if good milking practices are observed.

Leaf Vegetable Wastes U. S. department of agriculture scientists are experimenting with the possibility of making poultry feed by drying wasted portions of leafy vegetables. The leafy wastes, which amount to a staggering sum each year, make nutritious feed for chickens when the leaves are dried to preserve their feed value.

Spray for Roses A good spray for roses is one and one half table-spoonful of ferimate per gallon of water. Purpose of the spray is to control diseases such as black spot, powdery mildew and some of the other 15 diseases which frequently attack roses.
