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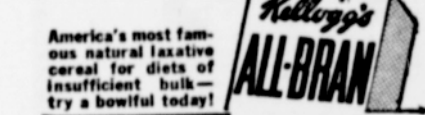

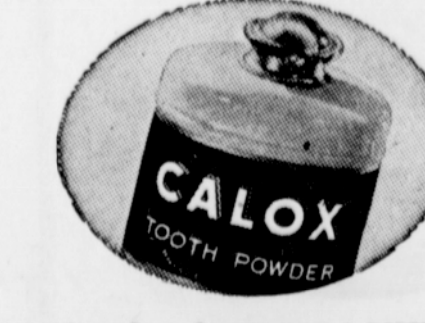

Test New Cancer Method
Scientists in the University of California medical school are testing a method of treating cancer by injecting anticancer drugs directly into arteries serving tumor areas. They hope thereby to cause maximum damage to cancer tumors and minimize the toxic effects of drugs on the whole system. The research, supported in part by the American Cancer society, is being conducted under the direction of Dr. Michael B. Shimmkin, director of the laboratory of experimental oncology, a joint venture of the university and the National Cancer Institute.
