

Kaesong Once Center Of Korean Power

Kaesong, the site accepted for truce talks between UN and Red Chinese-Korean leaders, is in line to pick up again a long lost historic spotlight.

Although left behind in modern times by many faster growing and developing Korean cities, Kaesong was once the center of Korean power and culture.

The town was made the capital of the Koryo, or Wang, dynasty in the early 900's A.D., and as such was the focal point for the first centralized control extended over the peninsula. Kaesong maintained its position for nearly 500 years, and after its fall the dynasty name was carried on in the name "Korea."

Meanwhile, toward the end of the weakening Koryo reign, numerous invasions by Mongols from the north had brought about foreign domination of the entire country for the first time. With the retirement of the Golden Horde and the rise of the new Yi dynasty, the capital, in 1392, was moved to Seoul.
