The Portland Bureau of Transportation's (PBOT)
Assistant Director oversees three program groups,
including: Policy, Planning & Projects; Development
Permitting & Transit; and Transportation System
Management. Through these groups, the Assistant
Director oversees a \$73M budget and a staff of over
200 employees. The primary programs within these
three groups include: policy development, capital
projects, active transportation, planning, develop-
ment review, streetcar, tram, parking enforcement,
parking garages, parking operations, and traffic
design. The Assistant Director position is under the
general direction of the PBOT Director but operates
with significant independence. The Assistant Director
performs the functions of the PBOT Director in her
absence, including directing the bureau, addressing
constituent issues, approving ordinances/contracts/
personnel actions, conducting media interviews,
testifying at City Council, making policy decisions,
and attending high-level meetings with stakeholders
and regional partner agencies. The Assistant Director
will be instrumental in carrying out the upcoming
Two-Year Work Plan through action item implementa-
tion within its groups. The Assistant Director will lead
strategic initiatives and be a catalyst for innovation in
service delivery.

The Assistant Director ensures that the work of its
three programs embraces equity and diversity in the
workplace and in the community. Customer service is
a key component of many of the programs under the
Assistant Director position. Managing the bureau
programs to accomplish high quality customer
service, while implementing city policy, is a primary
objective of this position.

The top priorities for the Assistant Director include:
implementing new capital projects; executing the NW
Parking District; securing a new Streetcar operating
agreement; overseeing the newly transitioned
Regulatory Division; leading the completion of the city
Transportation System Plan and Citywide Parking

projects; and guiding the establishment of a
development fee to address frontage improvements
