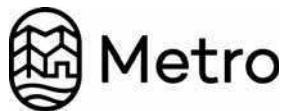

Sealed bids marked with "BID ENCLOSED" for the construction of the **Timber Reservoir** for the Timber Water District, Washington County, Oregon (Owner) will be received by HBH Engineers, 2316 Portland Rd., Suite H, until **2:00pm (Pacific Time), on December 7, 2016** by hand delivery and mail. Bids received after this time will not be accepted.

The work under this Contract will include the supply and erection of a new bolted epoxy-coated steel 55,000 - 75,000 gallon (depends on bid alternative selected) potable water tank including structural design, foundation, tank floor, tank structure, epoxy-coated steel roof, cathodic protection, tank appurtenances, related piping, and site preparation as shown on the contract drawings.
