Hillsboro's Winter Village outdoor ice skating rink is open at Orenco Station

Hillsboro's Winter Village, the region's only open-air ice skating rink, is open at Orenco Station for the holiday season. The annual ice skating tradition, which takes over Jerry Willey Plaza and features 3,000 square feet of ice, kicked off last month and continues through new year's day. Skaters of all ages and abilities are welcome to take the long loop around the rink, which measures 115 feet long.

After gliding on the ice, skaters are invited to take in the holiday spirit at Orenco Station with a hot beverage, activities for youth, a little shopping, or a bite to eat.

Winter Village is open through January 1, 2018. Skating hours during vacation are winter to 9:30pm. 10:00am Available sessions, which last 90 minutes each, begin at 10:00am, noon, 2:00pm, 4:00pm, 6:00pm, and 8:00pm. A 30-minute break to allow for ice resurfacing and skate maintenance takes place after each session.

The rink is open for a half-day on December 24
