see a Yankee-Red Sox game, it's not bad news for us, either."

MLB hopes the games in London grow European fan engagement and player development.

"We have 20 people from Europe under contract with major league organizations, We'd like to see that number grow," he said, "Obviously when you have a European player, a player from a particular country making his mark in the major leagues, it drives interest among the people in that country, and that's really important for

The NFL has played regular-season games annually in London since 2007, and the NBA since 2011. The NHL opened its 2007-2008 season London's O2 Arena but has not returned.

"Playing in Europe presents some challenges for us that the NFL doesn't have," Manfred said. "It's a lot easier for them to play in a soccer/football stadium, virtually impossible for us. So we do have additional challenges."
