Notice is hereby given that the Owner, City of Banks, will receive sealed bids for furnishing of all labor, materials, and equipment for construction of Park Street Waterline Improvements Project according to the Drawings and Project Manual including Specifications prepared by Kennedy/Jenks Consultants and accepted by the Owner and described in general as:
  - Replacement of existing 2-inch diameter water main with new 8-inch diameter water main within Park Street ROW connecting to existing water main on Sunset Avenue, Wilkes Street, and Woodman Avenue. Work includes installation of new water service lines, two new fire hydrants, and testing and disinfection.
  - Replacement of existing curb and sidewalk with new curb, gutter, sidewalk, ADA ramp, and driveway within Park Street ROW. Work includes installation of new drain lines to the new curb and gutter and pavement markings.

Bids received after the stated date will not be accepted. The submittal envelope shall be marked "Banks Park Street Waterline Improvements Project." A public bid opening will be held shortly after closing in the Banks City Council Chambers. Interested parties are invited to attend.

All bidders must submit, in a sealed envelope within two (2) hours of the date and time of the deadline when the bids are due, a completed First-Tier Subcontractor Disclosure Form in compliance with ORS 279C.370.

- 5. Bid security. Prospective bidders shall enclose with each Bid a surety bond, cashier's check, or certified check of the Bidder, made payable to the City of Banks, for 5 percent (5%) of the Bid as Bid Security. The bid bond/check shall be given as a guarantee that the bidder will execute the contract, if it be awarded, in conformance with the Contract Documents and shall provide the surety and bonds as specified herein within fifteen (15) days after notification of award of contract to the Bidder.

    - 2 Addenda will be issued no later than 2 days prior to Bid opening.
    - 3 Bids shall remain in effect and subject to acceptance for 60 days after the date of Bid opening. If a contract is awarded, it will be awarded within the period that Bids are subject to acceptance. (00100 paragraphs 15 and 16.6)
    - 4 The successful Bidder shall sign the required number of counterparts of the Agreement and deliver them together with the required bonds to the Owner within 15 days after the date of the Notice of Award.
    - 5 The Owner will sign the Agreement and deliver a fully-signed counterpart to the Contractor within 15 days after receipt of the required signed counterparts of the Agreement and Satisfactory Bonds from the Contractor. (00100 paragraph 19)
    - 6 The Owner may issue the Notice to Proceed at any time between the time the Agreement is fully signed by all parties and 90 days thereafter.
    - 7 The Contract time shall begin to run on the date stated in the Notice to Proceed and the Contractor shall begin construction at the site within 10 days thereafter but not before submitting required insurance certificates. 8 The Work shall be fully completed within the Contract Time which is stated in the Agreement.
    - 9 Progress payments shall be made monthly and shall cover work performed up to the Application for Payment Date which shall be the last day of each month. The Contractor shall submit its Application for Payment at least 5 days prior to the Application for Payment Date. The Owner shall make payment within 30 days after the Engineer issues a Recommendation for Payment.
