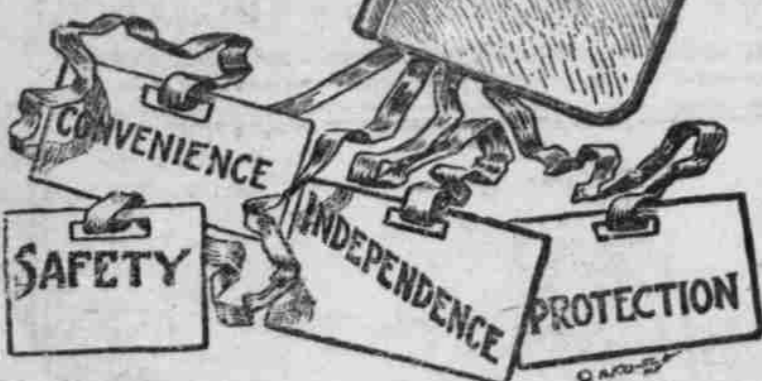

BIG PIONEER REUNION**

W. A. Templeton, president of the Linn County Pioneer Association, was in the city Saturday from Brownsville in connection with the annual reunion which will be held in that city June 18, 19 and 20th.

Mr. Templeton states that this year it is the desire of the board to make the pioneers' reunion a big family affair for all of this portion of the Willamette valley. Invitations will be sent to Salem, Springfield, Corvallis and other points inviting all to participate in the big celebration.

The number of brave men and women who withstood the hardships of the early days to open up the new country on this side of the Rocky Mountains is fast disappearing, and it is the intention of the Brownsville association to make the events of increasing importance.

Special attention this year will be paid to soldiers and sailors who have returned from service and the last day of the meeting, June 20 has been set aside for their reception. Every soldier and sailor in Linn county is invited to be present in uniform and take part in the ceremonies.

Weatherford of Albany, recently returned from France. There will be a big barbecue on that day.

The first two days of the meeting will contain some interesting events and reunions of old pioneers. The program is being worked out for the biggest and best meeting yet held by this association.

Thief Enters Rear Door and Carries Away Large Quantity of Jewelry and Cutlery.

Some time between 10 o'clock and midnight Saturday night a robber gained entrance to the M. C. Bressler and Son Hardware store and stole a large quantity of jewelry, knives, razors and shears, to the value of nearly \$1500.

The robbers entered the store by first taking out a pane of glass in a window near the rear door. Reaching in he pulled back the bar with which the door was fastened and entered. Two lights are always left burning at night, and these were turned off by the thief, after which he looted a large showcase located near the front windows containing a large display of jewelry, consisting of diamond rings, gold rings and various other articles of jewelry to the value of nearly \$1,000.

The thief then helped himself to a quantity of knives, razors and shears which were in a showcase near the center of the store. Evidently these articles were to his liking, as within easy reach were a quantity of safety razors and other valuables which were left untouched.

The loot was carried away in a bag and basket, both of which were taken out of the front display windows.

The robbery was not discovered until Sunday morning about 9:30, and upon receiving Sheriff Schless was notified, and he has been working on the case ever since, but at this time no clue has been found. It is believed the job was done by "home talent."
