to his equipment until now he has a 13 horsepower electric motor, double roll grinder and rolling machine, a first class seed and grain cleaner, one large warehouse dial scale and four other warehouse beam scales, an up to date wagon scale and a delivery truck. Mr. Morrison has five employes on his payroll, Miss Francis Travis, Fred Clingan, Robert Ward, James Gay and Cecil Mulligan, all of whom will remain with him. Mr. Morrison is now preparing to build another warehouse in Springfield. The new structure will be one-story, 66 by 80 feet, on the corner of Third and A streets, facing A. In explaining why he is able to sell at economical prices, Mr. Morrison mentioned the fact that he takes advantage of shipping by water

to Marshfield and then into Springfield by railroad, thus making a great saving on his cartons.

Mr. Morrison said that for this year his business would run somewhat over \$300,000, as that mark has been passed. He credited this splendid volume of business to the personal work and touch of his sales force.
