evening, was not held, because the building was not quite ready. It is now completed to the last touches.

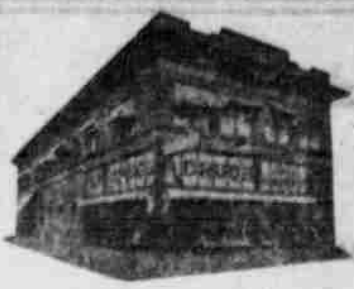
W. O. W. meets every Tuesday evening at W. O. W. hall.
