The constant extension of the rural route mail service is rapidly crowding out the village and rural postoffice.

During the last year only eight states showed an increase in the number of postoffices. There was a decrease in the number in other states and in the total number in the union. This decrease is likely to continue for some years.

State officials of the American Legion have announced for the one way round trip fare to the national convention, New Orleans, October 16th to 21st, sale dates will be October 8th to 16th, with final return limit of November 30th, allowing for extended stopovers in cities. Housing and identification arrangements are handled thru the State Adjutant of the American Legion.
