Parisian Sweets

1 pound reisins (seeded) 1 pound walnuts 1 pound dates

Prepare fruit by removing seeds and Put all fruits and nuts through food chopper using the coarsest cutter, poor soils mean small heads. Roll out on a heard to one-half inch thickness. Dust with powdered sugar, cut in squares. Almost any dried fruits may be used, such as prunes. pears, peaches, citron, etc. The squares may be dipped in chocolate if desired.
