ORDINANCE NO. 471

AN ORDINANCE imposing a license tax upon dogs, providing for its collection, prohibiting dogs from running at large in the Town of Springfield without a license, imposing penalties for the violation of this ordinance, repealing all ordinances in conflict herewith, and declaring an emergency.

THE TOWN OF SPRINGFIELD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There shall be paid into the Town Treasury of the Town of Springfield, a license fee upon each dog running at large within the corporate limits of the Town of Springfield as follows:

Upon each male dog and spayed female dogs, the sum of \$2.00 per year.

Upon each female dog the sum of \$5.00 per year.

All such licenses shall be paid for one year in advance, beginning the first day of May, 1924; and on the first day of May in each year hereafter; and ending at the 30th day of April, the next year; provided that for any dog brought into the Town after the first day of May of any year, then the owner thereof may secure a license for the remainder of the year upon the payment of one-half of the license fee mentioned in this section.

And for any dogs not within the Town before the first day of May in any year, but brought into the Town before the first day of November of such year, then the owner shall pay the full license fee specified in this ordinance.

SECTION 2. The license fee mentioned in Section 1 of this ordinance shall be paid to the Town Recorder during the month of May of each year; and upon payment of the same, the Town Recorder shall issue a license accordingly and shall furnish to the person paying such license fee a license tag, properly numbered to be attached to the collar of the dog licensed.

Passed by the Common Council this 14 day of April, 1924.
