88 PER CENT OF STUDENTS HAVE CHOICE CHURCH

University of Oregon, Eugene, Nov. 5.—(Special).—Eighty-eight per cent, or 2041 of the 2658 students who submitted information cards this year are church members, or have some denominational or religious preference, according to a report compiled by the campus Y. M. C. A. and Y. W. C. A. officials.

This figure shows a slight proportional decrease over last year when 92 per cent expressed some church preference.

Presbyterians lead with 560 giving this denomination their preference, while the Methodist Episcopalians come second with 381 and those of the Christian church, third, with 240.

Others in order of their totals are: Episcopalians, 205; Christian Scientists, 138; Catholics, 131; Baptists, 118; Congregationalists, 93; Lutherans, 37; Jewish, 18; Unitarian, 16; Latter Day Saints (Mormons) 12 and United Brethren, 4. Eighteen were miscellaneous.

Sixty-six simply marked protestant on their cards giving no denominational preference, while 617 did not mark the cards at all.
