**AGED PIONEER DIES AT DAUGHTER'S HOME**

Another of the pioneers of early Oregon passed away in the death last Friday of Orin Henry Starr. Mr. Starr died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. E. A. Fegles of Coburg and the funeral was held at the Walker chapel here Sunday afternoon.

Born in Frederick, Illinois in 1847, Mr. Starr came to Oregon when he was only 10 years old and settled in the Bellfountain district of Benton county. He engaged in the tin-smith business at Monroe for many years, and later lived in other parts of the state. In 1915 he moved to a small farm west of Springfield and lived there until Mrs. Starr died in 1922, when he began living with Mrs. Fegles.

Surviving are Ernest Starr of Portland, James of North Bend, Thomas of Vancouver, Washington and Mrs. Fegles.
