Nicotine sulfate as sold in Oregon in liquid form will keep indefinitely without loss of strength, says the experiment station. The highest grade is a solution of nearly 50 per cent nicotine sulfate in water containing 40 per cent nicotine. The only forms in which it is available are black leaf 40. Hall's 40 per cent nicotine, N. P. C. nicotine, and Ortho nicotine sulfate. Nicotine dusts may be either stable or unstable.
