Albert Brownlee, convicted slayer of Eston Hooker following the hold-up of the Veneta pool hall, on Monday was sentenced to be hanged on May 17. Brownlee will be taken to Salem within 20 days. The prisoner, when asked if he had anything to say to show cause why he should not be hanged, told Judge G. F. Skipworth that he was sentencing an innocent man.

4-L DISTRICT BOARD MEETING ANNOUNCED

Portland, Ore., April 7.—(Special) —The semi-annual district board meetings of the Loyal Legion of Loggers and Lumbermen, better known as the 4-L, will begin April 7 at Baker, when the district board of that district will meet with W. C. Ruegnitz, 4-L president, in the chair. The Bend district board will meet in that city April 14. The upper Puget Sound district will convene at Snoqualmie Falls, Wn., April 19, and will be followed by district meetings in Spokane, April 21; Hoquiam, Wn., April 25; Tacoma April 27; Eugene, April 29 and Portland, May 3. The 4-L district boards are composed of equal members of employees and employers in the lumber industry, elected by ballot. The function of the boards is to discuss business of district interest and to submit to the board of directors such matters as can not be settled by the district board, or matters of general import to the organization. The 4-L board of directors, the governing body, will hold its seventeenth semi-annual session in Portland, May 16. This board is composed of 12 employers and 12 employees.
