PHONE CO. TO ROTATE BILLS TO CUSTOMERS

A new method of issuing telephone bills, known as "Rotation Billing," will be introduced to customers of the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph company during March and April, according to J. L. Bland, manager for the company.

Under the new plan telephone users in Oregon will be divided into six different groups, each to receive its telephone bills on a different date—the 1st, 6th, 11th, 16th, 21st, and 26th of the month—instead of the first of the month as is now the practice.

The new billing date in Springfield, Mr. Bland said, will be the 21st of the month, starting in March. Customers will receive their bills about five days after that date.

The company is giving its customers full details of the plan in an announcement accompanying the regular March bills.
