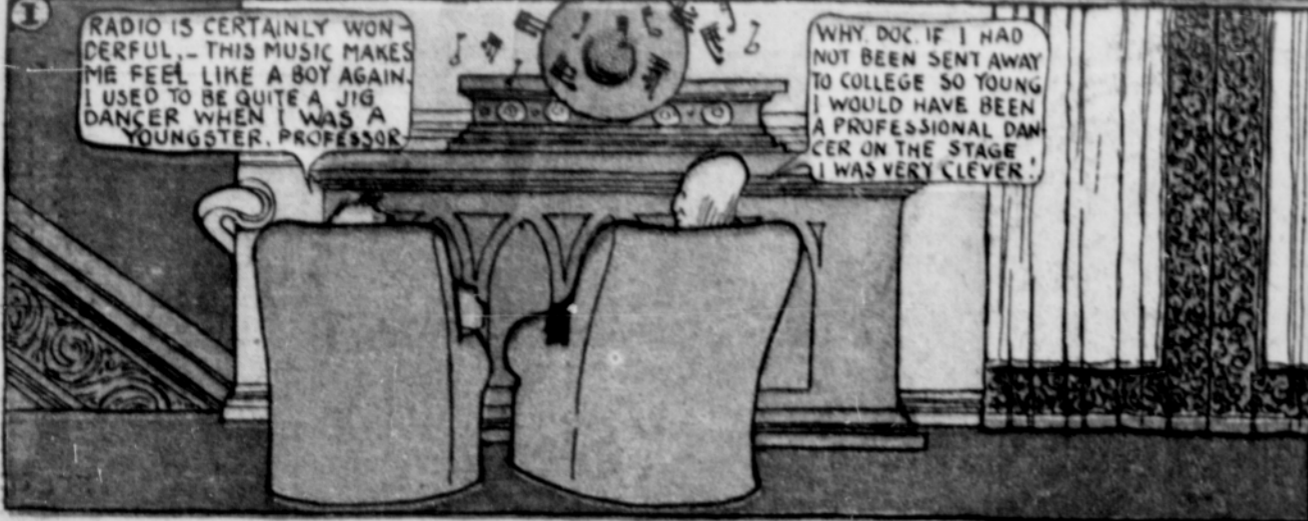


LITTLE NEMO IN *Slumberland*

OH! DOCTOR... PROFESSOR! HAVE YOU LOST YOUR MINDS?



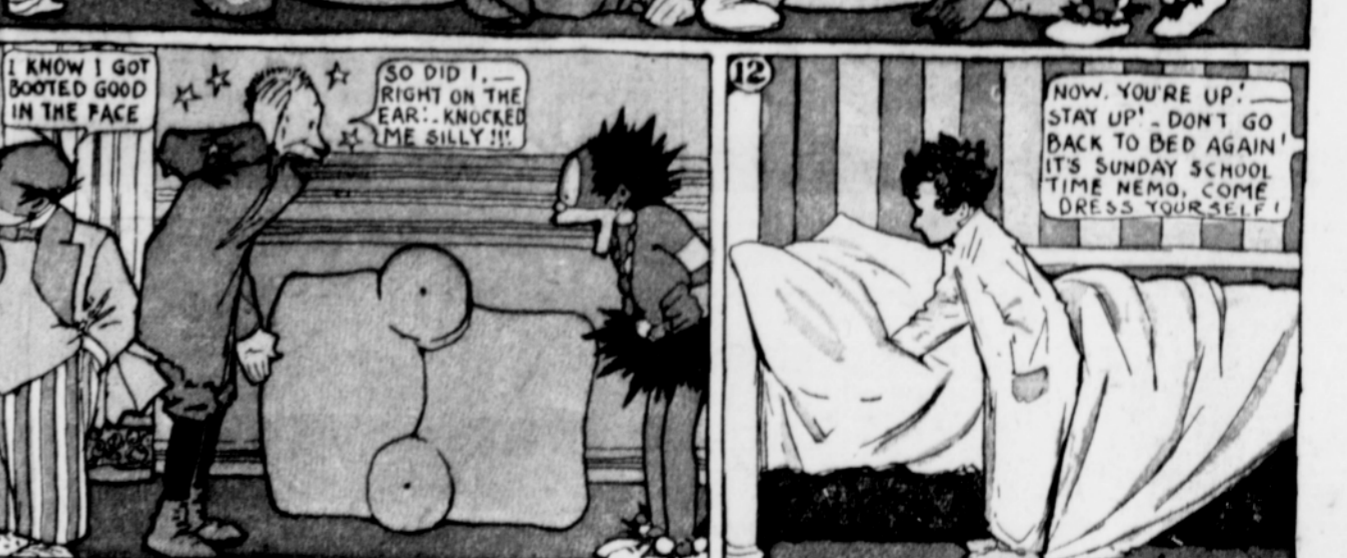
10 CAN I COME UP, DOCTOR?
