Law Allows Not to Exceed 10 Mills and Voting Must Be Held Next Month

Sixteen Lane county road districts have already presented petitions to the county court for the holding of special elections in November to vote on proposed special tax levies for road work.

Of the 61 county districts it is expected that about two-thirds may hold these special elections in November. Each district is allowed by law to vote up to 10 mills of total valuation.
