SCHOOL SUPPORT URGED BY HANLEY

Kerr, Not Zorn, Proper Man to Support Says Rancher of Harney County

Portland, Ore., Oct. 20.—(Special)—William Hanley, of Burns, former State Highway Commissioner and one of the largest livestock ranchers of eastern Oregon, today announced his unalterable opposition to the Zorn-McPherson School Moving Bill and declared for order by solution of Oregon's higher educational problems under the leadership of Chancellor Kerr and the State Board of Higher Education.

"In times like these," said Hanley, "the voters must expect to be pestered by such top-sidled propositions as the Zorn bill. Like all selfish measures," he continued, "the secret promoters of the bill made it appear that the Zorn bill was a consolidation and economy measure and would save the taxpayers a million dollars a year."
