ALFALFA IS BEST FORAGE FOR BEES

State-wide survey for three years lists production costs for various districts

Consider the bee—traditionally known for his—or rather, her—industry and freedom from unemployment.

That is just what some farm management and entomology specialists at the Oregon State college experiment station have been doing this past year—considering the bee and the methods under which it has been kept in Oregon.

Oregon Honey Valuable

Oregon is not a leading honey producing state, but does have a substantial honey industry points out A. S. Burrier, associate economist, who was in charge of the survey.

Production Regulates Price

Just as in dairy cost studies, the eastern Oregon alfalfa regions lead in low cost of production of honey, the first report shows.

NICOTINE HURTS TOMATO PLANTS

Plants Suffer Same as Individuals From Ravages of Tobacco Is Advice

Score one for the anti-tobacco leagues. Though the "weed" in some forms of sprays is a boon to orchardists in controlling pests, science now says that tobacco is the most common source of ordinary tomato mosaic, an incurable, infectious disease common to Oregon plantings.

The Oregon State college experiment station, as well as several other stations throughout the country, has demonstrated conclusively in recent years that tobacco in any form, including chewing, or smoking, and mild tobacco or raw, is a menace to tomato plants.

Cleanliness is Essential

One might conclude that control of such infectious diseases would be impossible, but such is not the case. The basis of control measures given in the circular is extreme cleanliness.

Even women who handle potatoes are a source of danger in working with tomato plants unless precautions are taken to cleanse the hands thoroughly before-hand.
