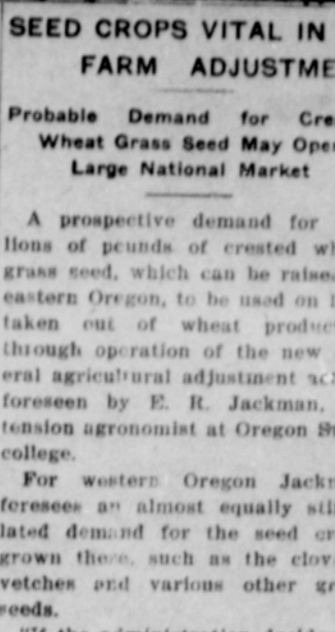

A prospective demand for millions of pounds of created wheat grass seed, which can be raised in eastern Oregon, to be used on land taken out of wheat production through operation of the new federal agricultural adjustment act, is foreseen by E. R. Jackman, extension agronomist at Oregon State college.
For western Oregon Jackman foresees an almost equally stimulated demand for the seed crops grown there, such as the clover, vetches and various other grass seeds.
