## BY THE EDITOR

The Albany Democrat takes ex-ceptions to what we said regarding the action of the Albany city council in denying responsibility of the big steel bridge at that city. It intimates that the county should look after that bridge as well as the one in this city. Now Brother Nutting you are well aware of the fact that the two cases have no similarity whatever, and we hardly believe that you would sanction the action of the court if it should take charge of the bridge at this time. Linn county did all she was asked to do at the time this bridge was constructed, and we see no good reason for the city to expect that the county should be responsible for the repairs that are now so badly needed. Had the interests of the county demanded the bridge no doubt that the county would have built it, and in which case the county would have kept it in repair, just the same as it does the bridge in this city, and all other county bridges. It is not right or just for the city of Albany to undertake at this time to shift the responsibility for their bad management onto the county, and even the citizens of that city do not sanction the plan, although they would undoubtedly favor some scheme by which the taxes of that city could be reduced, but that is of no concern to the taxpayers of the county.

The farmer's institute held in this city last week was a grand success. It was just the sort of a meeting that we had wished to see, and it is indeed gratifying to note that our people took such an active interest in the meeting. There were many farmers present, and all seemed well pleased with the result, and expressed themselves in many words of praise for what they had heard. Such meetings are bound to be productive of much good, and it gives the writer great pleasure to note the interest taken.

Joseph Bonch, a North Dakota cattle buyer, is in Portland, having come to Oregon to buy 5,000 head of cattle. He recently purchased 2,500 head in Idaho, paying \$18 for yearlings and \$25 for two-year-olds. He says cattle raising in Oregon is a profitable industry, as the mild winters here render feeding of cattle almost unnecessary, grass growing green on the ranges all winter.

Witnesses in the Cour d'Alone riot cases testify that the "bull pen" prison where the rioting miners were confined while under arrest, was a filthy, unhealthful, uncomfortable place. It might be stated that "bull pen" prisons, jails and penitentiaries are good places to stay out of, and ought not to be furnished tooluxuriously.

Now it is said that the people of Nicaragua want to be annexed to the United States. As we are about to build the Nicaragua canal, and will invest several million dollars down there, it might be the part of wisdom to annex Nicaragua. The country through which the canal will pass will be Americanized anyway.

The Oregon delegation in congress have had a conference with the speaker of the house concerning the Indian war veteran bill, and the outlook is now brighter than ever before for the passage of the measure, which will be good news to many worthy survivors of Indians in Oregon.

**THE DAIRY INSTITUTE**  
A Very Interesting Meeting Held in this City Last Week

The farmer's institute, held in this city last week under the direction of the Oregon Agricultural college, was as great a success as the most sanguine could have expected. The attendance was large, and the interest taken in the meeting by our farmers was indeed gratifying, and showed a desire on their part to assist one another and also to receive assistance and advice at the hands of those who have spent years in study and experiment to enable them to better understand the needs and methods of the farms.

The first session was held Thursday evening, at the M. E. church, and the attendance, while not as large as those which followed was very good. The meeting was opened by an address of welcome, by Hon. A. J. Johnson, of this city, and was delivered in a manner which caused the visitors to feel that they were welcome to the best that the city had to offer. The response by Dr. Withycombe showed plainly that the words of Mr. Johnson had been received in the spirit in which they had been intended, and was delivered in a very pleasing manner. Following this was an address on food adulteration, by Prof. John Fulton, which plainly set forth many of the methods employed in the adulteration of our food and food products. The evening program closed with a recitation by Miss Edie Shore, which was delivered in a very pleasing manner and was greatly appreciated. Excellent vocal music was interspersed during the evening, which added greatly to the program, and which demonstrated that our city is possessed of a number of good vocalists who are ever ready to assist when called upon to do their part in entertaining the public.

Friday morning at half past nine the second session was begun, and like that of the previous evening was well attended. The program was opened by an address on Forage Plants, by Dr. Withycombe, and was listened to with much interest by those who are interested in the raising of stock. A few minutes very interesting discussion followed, which gave all an opportunity to express their views on the subject, and like other discussions, it was a most profitable one. The subject of the meeting, Mr. Denny told how he raised clover, and to prove that he raised it he had some samples of clover, which were indeed a strong argument in favor of his methods of raising this variety of hay. Mr. Denny last year cut from three to five tons per acre from his field and in his address he told just how it was done. His remarks were followed by interesting discussion on the subject, which was followed by a few remarks on the "care of a cow" by Dr. Withycombe, which was indeed indeed interesting. The afternoon session opened with an address on "flax culture" by E. E. Larimore, manager of the N. W. F. & C. Co., of this city, and was of much interest to our farmer friends, especially those who are intending to grow flax, not only this year but in years to come. "Butter Making on the Farm" was the next subject presented, and was most ably handled by Mrs. J. H. Peery, of Larwood, and the address was made all the more interesting owing to Mrs. Peery's reputation as a butter maker. She told in no mistaken words just how she gained the reputation of being one of our best butter makers, and no doubt her remarks will be of untold benefit to many who are marketing hundreds of pounds of butter every year and who are compelled to accept the lowest market price for it owing to its lack of superior quality. After a lengthy discussion on butter making V. Cladek addresses to meeting on the manufacture of cheese, and he clearly demonstrated that the grain raising farmer was wasting his time in this valley, and that there was much more room for money making in the manufacture of cheese and butter on the farm than there was in trying year after year to pay off the indebtedness by raising grain at forty cents a bushel.

The last session of the institute was held at the city hall, and long before the hour of beginning had arrived the hall was crowded, and standing room was a premium. The program was opened by an address on poultry raising by Prof. E. L. Kent, which was very interesting and brought forth some discussion on the subject. By request E. E. Larimore sang a solo, which has very heartily received, after which Prof. Kent entertained and delighted the audience with a number of stereopticon views of the Agricultural college and the stock to be found there, the property of the college. The session was closed with a lecture on sight of hand, by V. Cladek, which proved very interesting, and showed Mr. Cladek to be an expert in this line of work. He performed several very clever tricks, which were pronounced far above those of the average performer.

The program as first arranged was considerably changed, and owing to sickness one number of the program was omitted, which would have been very interesting to the ladies present, being a paper on poultry raising, by Mrs. W. G. McDonald. Mrs. McDonald's little child was ill, and this prevented her from being present to deliver it, hence it was not read.

J. S. Morris, of this city, acted as chairman during the sessions, and



his effort on behalf of the institute are worthy of special mention, as without them, and the kind assistance of H. Shelton, the meetings could not have been the success that they were. There can be nothing but praise due those who so willingly assisted, especially those who assisted with vocal music, as well as the members of the mandolin club. These meetings are bound to be of much benefit to our people, not only the farmers who attended, but to the citizens of Scio, as well, and we hope that we will be able to have another institute in this city before another year rolls around, and we can assure the people who so kindly assisted in the one just closed that they will have the hearty cooperation of all our people when the time comes for holding another meeting of this kind.

## Death of Mrs. Kees

Mrs. Jacob Kees died February 23, 1900, at her home near Lebanon, at the age of 78 years. She was a pioneer of the early '50s. Her husband died two or three years ago leaving her property inventoried at about \$125,000 which she has since reduced mostly to money, making her the wealthiest woman in the county. Having no children the property will go to brothers and sisters. It is thought she left a will.

## Thomas Thompson found Dead

Friday afternoon Sam Hawken and family concluded to visit Thomas Thompson at his home near Mountain Home, about 8 miles north east of Brownsville. No one was found at home and as this was unusual search was made for Thompson. Mr. Hawken noticed a dog quite dead. The pup had torn off one ear, and torn away the side of the face. On investigation by some parties of foul play the coroner was notified.

Coroner Norman went to Brownsville Saturday evening, but he was not needed and did not go to the scene of the death, as there was no doubt that the death was from heart disease. Mr. Thompson was 73 years of age. He leaves a daughter, a student in Solvay College.
