### OUR 1908 FAIR

Over \$1000 in Premiums—Over 1500 in Special Awards

Immediately at the close of our very successful annual fair, held last month, President A. G. Prill commenced work in preparation for the fair of 1908. Correspondence was opened with seed firm, dairy supply houses, creameries, agricultural journals, stock breeders, etc., for the purpose of inducing them to offer special premiums. This effort has been quite successful, and it is expected that by the first of the year special premiums of July \$20 in value, will be listed. On Thursday afternoon at a meeting of the board of directors, the dates of the 1908 fair were fixed. September 2, 3 and 4 were the dates selected, and is just one month earlier than the fair held this year.

A premium list and racing program was adopted, which will involve the payment of over \$150.  
 Improvements to stock sheds, grandstand, race track, fencing to be built, etc., were also provided for.

The contract for printing the premium booklet was let to THE SANTIAM NEWS printer, to be ready for delivery about February 1.

The success of our first annual fair has resulted in greatly increased interest of people from all sections of the county. People who would not assist in any way in the past, are now willing to take hold and help to make the Seio Fair a County Fair in all respects.

The Board of Directors have every reason to feel satisfied with its first year's work. The deep interest manifested by the people in general, is evidence that the enterprise was undertaken at just the right time and at the right place. The future of the fair looks most promising. The adding of 100 names to the membership of the association, which is now assured, will place the Seio County Fair upon its feet and establish it so firmly that the annual fair of the future will be an event of the greatest importance to the people of Linn county.

### MORE ELECTRIC LINES

Articles of incorporation were filed in Portland this week by John McNary and C. L. McNary, of Salem, in behalf of A. Welch and the Willamette Valley company, forming a new company to be known as the Portland, Eugene & Eastern Railway company. The nominal capital of the new company is given at \$1,000,000. The stated purpose of the incorporation is to build an electric road from Portland to Salem, thence to Albany and south to Eugene, and also to connect ultimately with Yaquina Bay, on the coast, Corvallis and West Side points. From Eugene a branch line will be run eastward across the mountains to Oufarria. The branch line to Yaquina Bay will probably start from Albany, crossing the river at Corvallis and running thence west to the coast. The incorporators have been at work on the project for the past year.

Franchises have been secured in this city and Salem by A. Welch, and these will be immediately transferred to the Portland, Eugene & Eastern, Messrs. Story and Bacher, who are among the incorporators, are Chicago capitalists and represent still larger capital. They have lately invested five hundred thousand to a million dollars in Oregon timber, mostly in the southern portion of the state. This is the company that has completed the Eugene street railway line. It is building the interurban line from Eugene to Springfield. The company has already invested a good deal over \$100,000 in actual construction, surveys, rights of way and other preliminaries.

It is rumored that the great Potter-Palmer estate, of Chicago, is one of the forces behind this project, which, when fully developed, will be one of the greatest long distance electric projects in the whole United States.—Albany Herald.
