LOOK AT YOUR TILE DRAINS

Various Methods Found for Clogging Outlets, Which Must Be Looked Into Carefully.

To get the best service from our tile drains we must look to their activity several times each year, and especially so during the winter and spring season.

As much as one-half the tile drains upon our farms right now are not giving good service for varied reasons and are surely not profitable to the owner in such condition.

On our farm our tile drains empty chiefly into large open ditches and creeks and are quite easily kept from clogging, yet with a little carelessness in neglecting some of them they may quickly become clogged and useless.

Along these open ditches and creeks we find various methods of clogging up our tile drain outlets employed, which we must look into carefully, during the spring season.

Some thoughtless hunter in quest of rabbit plugged a chunk of wood into the drain in order to keep his game from entering and left the outlet clogged. Then we find that muskrats working along the open ditches have dragged ears of maize, grass and stalks into some of the outlets for nesting purposes.

With us we carry an iron rod with hook shaped upon one end and drag this foreign material from the tiles. Freshets often wash away some of the tiles, and often undermine the bank, causing heavy sods to drop down, completely burying our outlet, our only recourse being to shove this obstruction away, while other outlets with freezing and thawing have become clogged up from silt washing down, causing the water to be forced upward before emptying from the drain thus backing up water, making the drain inefficient.

We find this trouble mostly where short drains exist or those with little grade, lying dormant much of the time. We find it time well spent to go over our outlets several times each season.

BALANCED RATION FOR COWS

Can Get Along Without Corn, but for Good Results Succulence and Protein Are Needed.

An impression obtains that in making up the ration of a cow corn is absolutely indispensable.

No balanced ration is made up without corn for a basis. As a matter of fact corn is of minor importance when it comes to making up a dairy ration. We can get along without corn and get results but there are other things we cannot get along without and get results and these are succulence and protein.

Succulent foods are those which contain water. Protein is the most important element in milk. When it is remembered that 87 per cent of the milk is water, the importance of succulent foods is appreciated. Fat is also a content of milk but while nearly all the protein foods contain fat making elements the fat producing foods usually contain but very little protein and protein is what we need most if we want milk.

In order to get a ration in which the foods, most needed, are well-balanced we use corn, silage or root and alfalfa in some form or one of the by-products, like bran or oil meal. In pasture we find all the principles that the cow needs but while we can get along without succulence and corn, we cannot get along without protein.

In states like California, where corn is expensive, it rarely forms part of the ration. The fat is usually derived from one of the carbonaceous hays or straws. This is balanced most often with bran, shorts, middlings and alfalfa in some form. Often alfalfa is used for roughage with oats that have been cut to hay. Again the alfalfa is used in the shape of meal, with the wheat by-products to balance oats and straw.

And no one can complain that the cows do not do well both with regard to quantity and quality.

The Care of Lambs.

At eight to ten days of age lambs will begin to eat. At that time a creep should be built which will give them access to a feed box containing grain and a trough with hay. Box, trough and feed should always be kept sweet and clean.

A good grain ration for lambs is made as follows: Mix one-third part of oldmeal with one part each of bran, oats and fine corn meal. Red alfalfa hay or the second cutting of alfalfa hay are the most desirable form of roughage. Of the two alfalfa is to be much preferred.

It is a good idea to keep up the grain feed right along until the lambs are sent to market. By so doing the lambs are kept fat all the time and are ready to be turned into cash on short notice should the market take a sudden rise.
