Albany is the county seat is not reason enough for such a change.

Multnomah county fair is not held at Portland but at Gresham; Clackamas county fair is not held at Oregon City but at Canby; neither are county seats.

All over the United States you will find county fairs being held at towns which are not county seats. We will admit that our transportation facilities are not the best at the present time.

However, up to this time we have had no serious difficulty in handling all the people who wanted to come to the fair.

No propositions have, so far, been made by Albany for the removal of the fair to that place, and what might be done if proper methods were put forward we are unable to say.

Why not the balance of the county swing into line and assist Scio in building up its fair, rather than destroy it?

No better located or beautiful ground can be found in the county than the present one, being an ideal spot for a fair. City water is piped to all parts of the grounds, camping grounds adjacent to same, and a large tract of woods for free hitching grounds for farmers.

These things have been built up with but very little assistance from the outside, and should the county grant us the assistance which an undertaking of this kind warrants and justifies, there would remain no good reason for fault finding.

Albany had the county fair some years ago but allowed it to die on its hands. Does the Herald wish to have the same fate befall the one Scio has been nurturing? We might add in conclusion that the Linn County Fair is an incorporated body and also created by an act of the Oregon Legislature and hence will be a rather difficult thing for the Herald to corral. Live and let live, Brother. If the people of the county seat desire to keep the good will of the people of the Santiam country they will be careful how they attempt to dispoil us.
