Fingernail Photography.

The main skill of the manicurist consists in rendering the photograph watertight; which is done by coating it over with a shellac-like substance, which is burned upon the nail. Mothers have pictures of their favorite and prettiest children placed on their fingernails; young men and maidens display their sweethearts in the same fashion, and the fad has spread marvelously since it was first introduced. SUIT LONG DELAYED

KANSAS WOMAN SUES FOR DIVORCE AFTER 20 YEARS.

Action Was the First Big Luxury in the Self Sacrificing Life of Deserted Mother of Eight Children.

Chicago.—Mrs. Ernest B. Case indulged herself in a luxury the other day, the first big luxury, by the way, she has had in twenty years. The luxury was a suit for divorce.

Nearly twenty-one years ago Mrs. Case was living at Sedgwick, Kan. She was a well preserved woman of forty then, with a brood of eight young children around her—and a husband.

One day the husband disappeared. He went off to town ostensibly on a marketing expedition, leaving the wife and her eight young children on the lonely little farm together. He never came back.

It required almost the whole of the first three months for Mrs. Case to realize she had been deserted. She had hoped against hope that such a thing could not be true, that this humiliation had been spared her, but finally she found herself face to face with the fact.

Then she made up her mind to forget the past and turn resolutely to the future for her children's sake. Four years went by. With the aid of kindly neighbors she managed to eke out a living on the farm. At the end of the four years one of the neighbors who had shown interest in her affairs suggested that she should get a divorce. But Mrs. Case refused.

"I couldn't," she said, "because of the children."

Ten years slipped by, years of bitter hard plodding, because the children had to be reared and fed and educated, and it all took money. But at last some of the children reached maturity and then the work of the mother grew lighter. They all by this time had learned the story of the recent father, and the older of them urged, almost commanded, their mother to start the proceedings that would give her a legal separation.

Again Mrs. Case refused. She did not tell the children why, but the reason was that in addition to an innate aversion of divorce she had the conviction that the fact she was a divorced woman might militate against her daughters' marriages.

The oldest daughter married the son of a neighbor and moved to Chicago. One by one the others of the little flock except the youngest—a favorite son—married, moved away, and were settled in life.

Mrs. Case and her boy at last found themselves alone on the farm. He was a quiet boy. His mother loved him above all the others because his health was delicate. When she found that he was pining because the other children had gone from the farm and that his strength was growing less every day, she decided to sell the farm and move to the residence of the married daughter in Chicago. She came a short time ago. The favorite son died a few weeks later.

Then for the first time in her life Mrs. Case found herself free—free to dispose of the rest of her life as she wished. Her daughter had heard the deserting husband was in Kansas City. She renewed her urging that a decree be obtained. Mrs. Case yielded. The suit was filed in the superior court.

ALLOWS SLEEPING IN CHURCH

Massachusetts Pastor Will Permit Tired Attendees Upon Services to Rest Without Disturbance.

Cambridge, Mass.—Sleeping men will find a welcome at the Union Congregational church here, according to an announcement made by the pastor, Rev. Dr. Allan Stockdale.

The minister heard recently that many men were unwilling to attend church services because of the fear that they would disgrace themselves by going to sleep. This is his reply: "Let them come here; they may go to sleep if they want to. They will not worry me at all; on the other hand, sleepers often cause me pleasure. Heavy air and heavy sermons are also responsible. The music is soothing, too. Let the man fall asleep; the rest will do him as much good as the sermon, perhaps."

Ray-Killed Bacteria.

A method for sterilizing milk without heating or adding preservatives is claimed to have been effectively demonstrated recently in Holland. An apparatus has been constructed, it is explained, whereby the milk flows in a thin stream along an electric light, the ultra-violet beams working on the bacteria. The result is attributed to the quality of the ozone formed under the influence of the light.—The Argonaut.
