**BEST LOCATION FOR HOUSE**

Slight Elevation, Having Proper Drainage, With Northern Protection, is Greatly Preferred.  
In selecting a location for a house there are certain points that should be held in mind. A slight elevation, having proper surface drainage, with protecting hills or woods on the north, is greatly preferable to a narrow valley, a low meadow, or the north side of a hill. The house should face so as to get sunlight into all the rooms, if possible, for "where sunlight does not enter the doctor must." This may be accomplished by facing the house southeast, for example, instead of directly east or south.

After the selection of the site some study should be given to the character of the soil, the principal factors to be considered in this connection being the water and the air. There is a certain amount of moisture in the upper layer of the soil which is the cause of damp and unhealthy foundations. This dampness is derived mostly from the surface water, and is directly proportional to the absorptive power of the soil and can be diminished by tiling and trenching. The ground air is rendered impure by the gases arising from the decomposition and putrefaction that are constantly going on in the soil, especially in that which is contaminated by household wastes.

**TO DEVELOP DAIRY HEIFERS**  
Great Care Taken in Milking Young Animal Quietly as Possible to Avoid Kicking Habit.

Our endeavors to develop our dairy heifers into persistent milkers start when the heifer has its first calf, writes William Turner to Farm and Dairy, Petersboro, Ont. We take great care in milking the heifers using them as quietly as possible so as not to get them in the habit of kicking. Many a heifer is spoiled during its first year from lack of such care.

If the heifer shows signs of drying too soon, we still continue to milk her even if the quality of milk does not pay for the time spent. We know, however, that we will be doubly repaid during the next period of lactation, for she will then keep up the flow until the proper time to stop.

A cow that has got into the habit of slackening in her milk flow too soon after calving can be made into a good milker by persistent care. We bought a cow four years ago that in her first season of milking was almost dry in six months. We still milked her, however, and she is now a grand milker.

**Prime Vegetables.**  
A vegetable grower in western Pennsylvania has been highly successful in supplying his local market with the very best vegetables. He has always endeavored to grow strictly first-class vegetables and this has made it possible to obtain prices considerably above the average. For example, he grows pink or purple fruited tomatoes, not because they are better than red tomatoes, but many people think they are better. He grows only two varieties, namely, Globe and Magnus. The price which he received from merchants the past season ranged from two to eight cents a pound. Even the minimum price of two cents a pound is excellent after the middle of August. Again, this gardener has been growing cauliflower far above the average in quality. He uses a select strain of Snowball for both early and late crops. Some heads have weighed six pounds and he has sold them at fancy prices.

**Scotch Cattle Sell High.**  
The Christmas sale of cattle and sheep which is held annually following the Smithfield fat stock show was held as usual at the cattle market in London. The quality was extremely good and the prices excellent. There have been fewer animals from the United States sent to England than formerly, and this has been the cause of this season's firmer prices. Many people who last year were buying American stock have been buying English meat. The pick of this market was 600 Scotch cattle, including Angus and other breeds, that brought as much as \$10.57 for 100 pounds live weight.

**Big Money in Medicinal Crops.**  
The production of medicinal plants as farm crops is receiving some attention. Dr. E. L. Newcomb of the Minnesota University, asserts that fergo, from which digitalis is obtained, yields in his garden at the rate of \$4.56 to the acre. He raised 100 pounds worth \$1.20 a pound, produced on 1,120 square feet, which the professor figures out at the rate per acre mentioned.

**Imported Potatoes.**  
There are three or four times as many potatoes grown in Europe as in this country. Regular shipments of European potatoes arrive in New York and occasionally reach as far west as Chicago.

**HEALING ART IN NINEVEH**

Medicines and Other Cures Employed There 650 Years Before the Christian Era.

The patient work of the archaeologist enabled people in 1911 to form a very fair idea of medical science as it existed in Nineveh 650 years before the birth of Christ. Of the 20,000 tablets taken from the Library of Assurbanipal, the great King of Assyria, who conquered Egypt and Babylonia and established his subjects in the deserted cities of Samaria, hundreds deal exclusively with medicine and contain numerous prescriptions:

"If a man has colic make him stand up and pour over him a decoction of hypericum and he will recover.  
"Or make him crouch down on his heels and pour cold water over his head."  
Faith healing seems to be indicated in a prescription which runs "If he is in a weak state, make him bend down, then raise his legs, and say: 'May you get quite well.' Strike him also on the head fourteen times with your thumb."

Many prescriptions deal with the cure of a disorder which was very common at Nineveh, and which seems to have been due to overindulgence in food and drink. "When a man is bilious rub him with an onion, and let him drink nothing but water and abstain from food altogether."

Among the medicines used by the physicians of Nineveh were sesame, olive oil, castor oil, syrup of dates, honey and salt. Fasting and massage were frequently ordered.
