and the water pressure to fill the pipes is by air pressure in the tank. This results in cool water in summer with about the same temperature in winter. As no water pipes are outside the buildings Mr. Denny is never troubled with frozen water pipes in winter. Hot and cold water

is ever ready in the bathroom, in the kitchen, in the wash house and elsewhere where needed. A septic tank takes care of all the wastage.

A fine bunch of hogs, a large flock of chickens, horses and plenty of other stock indicated a prosperous farm home. Mr. Denny informed us that the buildings and other improvements immediately about the dwelling represented an

expenditure of about \$6000.

After partaking of another bountiful meal and much pleasant conversation we boarded the car for Scio. The entire distance we traveled, as shown by the speedometer, was 65 miles.
