Dairy Hints
 Keep the calves keen for their meals. Overfeeding is one of the chief causes of digestive troubles.
 A cob fire in the watering tank results in more milk in the pail and more money in the bank.
 All tinware should be sterilized. The sterilization of utensils is an important factor in producing high-grade milk.
 Where no silage is available, a cow will consume two pounds of good dry roughage per 100 pounds live weight. If silage is available, then feed one pound of dry roughage and three pounds of silage per 100 pounds of live weight.
 The question of what to feed the dairy cow is very important. Economical production requires a balanced ration first, then feed each cow according to her individual requirements, such as her size, and the quantity and quality of milk produced.
