Artistic Motifs in Latest Silks

Architecture and Painting Are Used for Designs of Dress Materials.

It seems a far look into the future to consider the new dress materials as they come from the ateliers of their authors, says a Paris fashion authority in the New York Times.

Last year it was the iron work of Brandt from which were taken the graceful lines of the "Feronier" crepes and chiffons, of which the smartest summer styles were made and which are still popular for the softer frocks, negligees, linings and scarfs. The success of these was so concrete and far-reaching that the artists have gone again into great buildings for their inspiration. They have found it in the stained glass windows of cathedrals, cloisters, and classic assembly halls and have established their first examples in models at the Paris exposition. These Vitraux d'Art created by Mme. Jean Ferres express in the colored mosaic and leaded lines the ultra modern, the futuristic form of design; and this scheme entire has been transferred to the silks that come from American looms. They have been adapted with the greatest latitude in patterns and of colors, attaining results never visualized by their authors.

Reversing sharply the bright, sometimes violent colors of the last seasons, these new silks will bring back the pastel shades, with more vitality. The first things for spring, brought out to meet the requirements of the Palm Beach season, will be done in the most entrancing violets, mauves, greens and turquoise blue. In some of the floral designs, the most delicate and the richest of all the motifs, an occasional top note is introduced in the vivid Russian colors, with a startling and ar-

Velvet and Velveteen on Winter Style Card

Suits, long coats and ensembles are here in such bewildering variety that the difficulty lies not in finding something becoming and appropriate, but in limiting one's choice.

Many of the new coats have much movement around the hem, produced by the introduction of circular godets and plaits. Sometimes this fullness is in back, sometimes in front, and occasionally one sees it placed at the sides. Many of the new wraps have all the fur at the neck and around the cuffs, while a very popular model has a band of fur stretching from neck to hem. A coat of unusual luxury is made of a soft woolen material in a clear red. The coat is lined with fur and this lining is so arranged that both coat and lining can be worn separately.

Velvet and velveteen promise to play an important part in the winter's program. Very successful are coats of black velvet worn with long straight tunics of contrasting color and material. An attractive model is of black velvet, trimmed with ermine, and worn with a tunic of green and gold tinsel brocade.

The dainty points in the costumes of great ladies and court dandies are appearing in a good many of the smart styles of this season; in the lace edges and frills with which so many things are finished. The very newest handkerchiefs have ruffles of net or lace sewn on the infinitesimal rolled, not hemmed, edge. Collars, revers, jabots or informal frocks are finished with lace or with a ruffle of footing.

Shirred Effects on Wraps

Shirred effects, first noted in the little velvet hats, have extended to dresses and evening wraps. The shirred velvet evening cape and coat are seen very often. Two-piece dresses of crepe de chine very often employ shirring for decorative treatment.
