The Wells of Andalusta

In Andalusia the norias or Moorish wells are sure to catch your eye. They are worth examining by the curious in such natters; the construction is very simple. out they do effective work. A broad wheel is turned round by an old mule, who is past other work, and attached to this wheel are earthen jars; as it revolves the empty jars pass into the water and come up full, then as they turn over they empty their contents into a reservoir, whence a trough or aqueduct of some simple kind provides for honsehold use, conveys the rest of the water into the fruit or vegetable garden and irrigates it by means of channels dug in rows in the arth. For drinking purposes the water is generally caught from the jars, for the Spaniards, though they like their fish "high" and their oil and bacon rancid, are very particular about the quality of their water, and are willing to buy it from the carriers who often fetch it from long distances if that near at hand has an evil reputation .-- Cor.
