Men who have the nerve to adopt radical measures deserve te succeed, and since Col. Maury has demonstrated that the plague can be effectually and safely combatted, we trust that all other orchardists will emulate his example and, arraed with a spray pump and a duly approved decoction of bug medicin . reach every twig on every tree next winter, and, by vigilence and care, retain the reputation of our country as the chief fruit section of Oregon.
