Aluminum.
Aluminum, it is generally known, is a metallic element found in clay and is the same material of which rubies, sapphires, emery and alum are made. It enters into the composition of a large number of other materials, and it is estimated that in the various compounds aluminum forms about one-twelfth of the crust of the earth. Every brick in every building is said to be 30 per cent aluminum. It is produced by the decomposition of clay, which is a salt composed of silicic acid combined with aluminum. The aluminum is separated from the silica by the application of electricity. Separation has never been successfully done in any other way.—Boston Globe.

I have never seen blindness over come that long, and I much doubt if they ever do to a greater length. They are not hard to cure, though in an eye ball they can run about as fast as a man can. When caught they struggle desperately until they find there is no opportunity to escape, when they will give up fighting and may be treated with impunity. I have never found those stupid to be victims. They can be treated easily, and their life is saved. They can appear pretty bad if they get a long period of blindness, but the best chance to break a case—Foster and Stevens.
