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**IONE COMMERCIAL CLUB**

**CONSTITUTION**

Article I. The name of this association shall be "The Ione Commercial Club."

Article II. The object of this association shall be for the promotion of all public enterprises affecting the City of Ione and vicinity in Morrow County, Ore.

Article III. The members of this association shall be the citizens of this county, and such other persons as may be elected in accordance with the By-Laws to be hereinafter adopted.

Article IV. The officers of this association shall be a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and such other officers as may be elected. The President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer shall constitute a Board of Directors.

Article V. This Association shall be a non-political, and shall be organized to the advantage of no candidate for public office.

Article VI. This Association may be amended by a vote of two-thirds of the members present at any regular meeting. PROVIDED that 10 days notice of the proposed amendment shall be published in The Ione Bulletin.

**BY-LAWS**

Section 1. Any citizen of Ione and of Morrow County, Ore., of good business standing and favorable to the interests of the City of Ione and vicinity may become a member of this association.

Section 2. Candidates for membership shall make application to the Secretary or Treasurer, who, at the next regular meeting of the association, or at any special meeting called for that purpose, shall present the application for membership and it shall be accepted. PROVIDED, that more than 2 votes are cast against his or her admission at such regular or special meeting, and thereafter the applicant shall be deemed a member upon the payment of \$2.00 membership fee, and the signing of the Constitution and By-Laws.

Section 3. The membership fee shall be the sum of \$2.00 payable on the adoption of the constitution and by-laws, and thereafter shall be a monthly fee of \$1.00 in advance on the first regular meeting of each month.

Section 4. The monthly dues of each member shall begin with and be payable at the next regular meeting after which he shall have been elected. Neglect to pay dues or other liabilities to the association for more than 30 days after notice shall constitute delinquency and exclude him from the privileges of the association; and in the event of such delinquency for two months his or her membership shall be forfeited and his name stricken from the membership roll.

Section 5. Resignations may be received by the Board of Directors, and shall be in writing, and shall be filed in the office of the Secretary. Resignations shall be in writing and shall be filed in the office of the Secretary.

Section 6. All charges against members shall be paid and settled on or before the 15th day of the month following the date of the delinquency, or until their successors are elected.

Section 7. The President shall preside at all meetings of this association and board of directors when present.

Section 8. In the absence of the President, the Vice-President shall perform all of the duties of said office, and in the absence of both the President and Vice-President, then the association at its regular or special meeting, or the Board of Directors at their regular or special meeting, shall elect a President pro tem, who shall perform all of the duties of the President at that meeting.

Section 9. The Treasurer of this association shall receive, transmit and disburse all funds of this association, in his name and in the name of the Board of Directors, and shall keep a correct account of all receipts, disbursements and other transactions of the association, and shall submit a monthly report to the Board of Directors of this association. And at the expiration of his term of office shall turn over all accounts and all other matters of the association to his successor in office, making his receipt therefor.

Section 10. The Secretary of this association shall have the custody of all records, books, papers and other documents of the association, and shall see that the same are preserved and that the same are accessible to all members of the association. All other committees to report when instructed to do so by the Board of Directors or by this association. Special committees may be appointed at any time by directors of the association.

Section 15. The annual meeting of the association shall be held on the last meeting of each year, at which time the new officers shall be installed and the outgoing officers shall make their annual reports.

Section 16. The regular meetings of this association shall be held on the 1st Monday of each month. Special meetings may be called by the President and upon request in writing of 5 members it shall be his duty so to do. PROVIDED, that 10 days notice of the purpose thereof shall be posted on a bulletin in front of the association rooms or published for one week in a weekly newspaper in Morrow County or by mailing a written notice to each member three days before the date previous to such meeting.
