118 portal is probably the most modern in feeling of any doorway to any of the main group of exhibit palaces. The portal is Italian ren-alssance in form and treatment, but much of the ornamentation is of more recent origin. The photograph gives no idea of the great dimen sions of this portal, which is sixty-six feet in height to the tip of the orns mentation surmounting the arch. The engles above the line of pilasters of the portal are six feet in height. The Exposition palaces are constructed of grayish cream plaster to imitation of Travertine marble.
