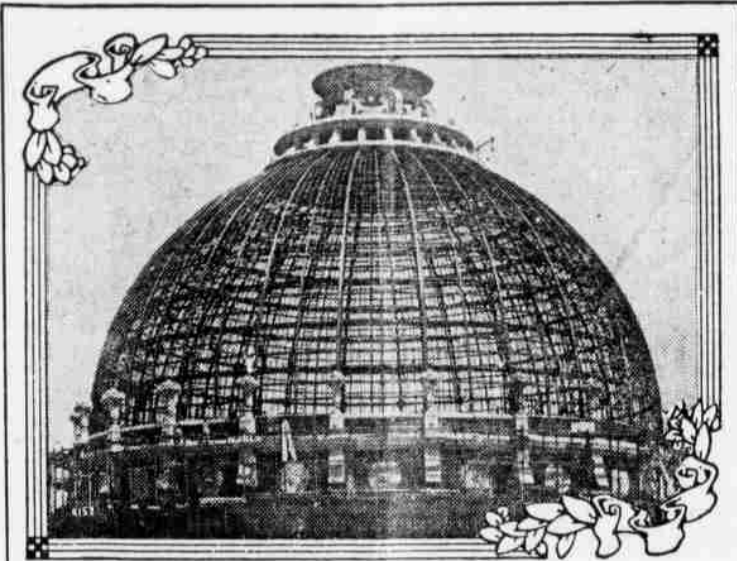

**THIS IS THE GREATEST QUESTION OF THE HOUR**

 Sixty billions of dollars of stock and bonds drawing 5 per cent, three billions five hundred millions; thirty billions which are fictitious fraud, made of mere printed paper created by a trick and each year they take 2 billions, five hundred millions. This vast sum is taken from the masses of the American people through the private ownership of these great wealth-producing machines built on class legislation. That gives the corporations this great taxing privilege, levying this great tribute on the American people as the fadel lords did in the old European countries up to the signing of the Magna Carta of England.

**This is the Question of the Hour.**  
 The people of the United States have saved up and deposited in savings banks over 5 billions of money (and there is less than 4 billions of all kinds in American money) at 4 per cent. They receive 2 hundred millions if dollars annually. They received the same rate forty years ago, when the 2 hundred millions bought what today requires 4 hundred millions to pay for.  
 Today the railroads of the country are doing more to paralyze the country's business than any other industry. They are asking a 5 per cent raise on freight rates. They have stopped constructions and are trying to keep it stopped until they are allowed to add further to the people's cost of living. Nothing has a greater and more direct effect on the cost of living than railroads. Every dollar they take from the people in the form of freight and passenger rates is so much added to the cost of living. Why is it

that England has taken over her railroads, finances and called heads of manufacturers, realty dealers, etc., and fixed a price on all commodities, adopting the Socialist theory of production and distribution in time of war, if not practical? Why would it not be more so in times of peace? The cost of living will not decline until these billions of money which are taken from the farmers and wage earners are re-distributed through co-operation.  
 When cornered by the Interstate Commerce Commission, former President Yoakum of the Frisco confessed that the only way to end looting by American railways and the scandalous financial transactions was for the Government to own and operate them.  
 Turn to the published Congressional report and read the testimony of the New York bank presidents that their banks had earned 2800 per cent on their capital stock in twenty years. And if one is puzzled he has but to observe the marble palaces in different cities which have been built to get rid of the profits made from borrowing the people's money at 4 and 2 1/2 per cent and loaning it back at any old rate.  
 And go through the country and listen to the hardest working men and women on earth, why it is they are compelled to work like slaves and are only allowed to retain enough of their earnings to keep body and soul together that the holders of our 8 to 12 per cent mortgages may take the balance when 90 per cent of men and women who reach 65 years of age are either dependent on their children or charity for their support. This is a burning question with the people.  
 Listen, do you hear any candidate in this state saying anything about these questions or offering any legislation to release the people from these burdens? NO. Only the Socialist party. Why do not any of the other parties have anything to offer? It is because they are committed to the policies of the competitive system that has produced these conditions and these conditions will grow harder to bear from year to year as long as we have this system of government based on competition—until we have a governmental system based upon co-operation democratically managed.
