

South Portal to Palace of Food Products, Panama-Pacific International Exposition, San Francisco, 1915



IIIS portal is probably the most modern in feeling of any doorway to any of the main group of exhibit palaces. The portal is Italian renalssance in form and treatment, but much of the ornamentation is of more recent origin.
