"MAXIM SILENCER" FOR SHIPS

It is Claimed They Will Absolutely Do Away With Noise Made by the Motors.

Eight ships now sailing the Pacific ocean are equipped with great silencers, weighing 8,000 pounds each, the invention of Hiram Percy Maxim, famous as the inventor of the gun silencer bearing his name.

"The motor-driven ship is the ship of the future," Mr. Maxim said recently. "However, in the past there has been one great disadvantage, the terrific noise of the motors. The new silencer we expect will solve that problem."

Mr. Maxim said that, inasmuch as his patents have not been issued, he cannot disclose the construction of his new invention. However, in general principle it is not unlike other Maxim silencers, depending on accomplishing its work by absorbing the recoil and hence silencing the terrific exhaust.

Immigrants' Literary Test

Immigrants subject to the literary test at Ellis Island now have to read thirty or forty words from the Protocols in any language they prefer. Immigration inspectors are equipped with cards in all languages, with verses from the Psalms printed in them. All types of script are represented—German, Arabic, Hebrew, Japanese, Russian and so on, except Chinese, for that nationality is not permitted to immigrate.

Repairing U-Boat Damages

If British shipbuilding has not yet reached pre-war figures the world has done wonderful things in ship production in the last twelve months. The total tonnage launched was 7,144,549, according to Lloyd's Register, and the British share was 1,020,000 tons. The feature of the returns is the expansion of shipbuilding in the United States and in Japan. The former appears at the head of the table with 57 per cent. of the world's output, and more than twice the tonnage built in the United Kingdom. Japan, with 611,500 tons launched, has built more shipping in one year than it did in the 22 years to 1912.
