WARNING TO THE PUBLIC

There are certain lots and parcels of land in the City of Heppner, and particularly in the business district that are kept in such a condition that they are a nuisance to the city, with their refuse and other things, and the owners and occupants of these lots have been repeatedly requested to remove the refuse and unsightly conditions, but so far such requests have been without avail.

Section 2: And herein to wit: persons who are the owners or in the possession or control of the premises of any lot situated within the corporate limits of the City of Heppner, and who shall allow or permit any filth, paper, lumber, bottles, cans, or other refuse, to be deposited, stored, or piled on or about the premises...

on said lot, piece or parcel of land, on any street or alley within said city, or on any lot, piece or parcel of land, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00, nor more than \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the city jail for not less than two days nor more than twenty-five days.

Section 4: Any person or persons who are in the possession or control of any lot, piece or parcel of land, or any pool of water within the corporate limits of the City of Heppner, who shall allow or permit said lot, piece or parcel of land, or pool of water to become or remain offensive or unwholesome shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00, nor more than \$25.00, or by imprisonment in the city jail for not less than two days nor more than twenty-five days.
